Continue through Via delle Terme and Piazza del Limbo, one of Florence's oldest squares, where you'll enjoy a **surprise tasting**, an authentic Tuscan delicacy. As you follow the path of the Vasari Corridor from the outside, your guide will reveal stories of Medici power and mystery. Cross **Ponte Vecchio** and discover **historic wine windows**, many of which have been recently restored. These small openings in noble palaces were used in the past to sell wine directly to Florentine citizens: today, they make for a perfect photo spot and an unforgettable experience.

Your journey continues past Palazzo Pitti and Piazza Santo Spirito and near Palazzo Strozzi you'll enjoy a glass of Tuscan wine served from an original wine window, just as locals did centuries ago. A tour filled with history, legends, and hidden gems—perfect for those seeking an alternative and authentic experience.

A WALK IN BOLOGNA THROUGH PORTICOS, PIAZZAS & TOWERS


